Hence this letter of Intent.



3. This letter of intent is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipments and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
 - (ii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report should be rectified. A copy of inspection report is enclosed.
 - (iii) No student should be admitted in the above college till the formal permission of Central Govt. is granted.
 - (iv) The applicant should provide a Bank Guarantee of Rs.7.00 crores (Rupees 1.50 crores towards medical college and 5.50 crores towards hospital facilities) valid for five years from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank as per the norms of the Medical Council of India.
4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for starting of a new medical college at Kanchipuram, Tamil Nadu by your Trust will be initiated on receipt of a compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated in the paragraph 3 above.
5. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.
