#### Report on teaching sessions carried out on the relevance and operational features of Immunization Clinic

Immunization activities are undertaken for children every Wednesday, in line with the national guidelines. Students are taught about immunization in both theory and practical sessions.

II and III MBBS students are taken in batches to the nearby government health facility and explained about cold chain. Students posted in the Pediatric department as a part of rotational or block posting will be observing the activities like finding the expiry date, Vaccine Vial Monitor, drawing vaccine from the vial, preparing the parts, route of administration, position of needle, instructions to parents after vaccination.

**CRRI** posted in the department are trained in the maintenance of cold chain and administer vaccine to children under the guided supervision of the faculties. All these immunization activities are carried out in the Rural Health and Training Center under the supervision of Lady Medical Officer and Pediatrician.

As per the MCI guidelines didactic lectures on Immunization is taken in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Final MBBS, by the department of Pediatrics and Community Medicine stressing on the importance of immunization, National Immunization Schedule, age at Immunization, Site, dose, route of administration, adverse effects following Immunization (AEFI) and how to report AEFI. They also update students on recent updates and changes in National Immunization Schedule. The departments teach about individual vaccines, origin and type of vaccine while teaching about individual diseases.

Department of Pediatrics conducts lecture on National Immunization schedule, Principles of Immunization, AFP surveillance, pulse polio program, vaccine and vaccine preventable diseases, adverse effect following the vaccine and newer vaccines. Additionally, CME's are conducted to update knowledge on Immunization.
